In 2004 we gave £3600 to enable a well to be sunk at a village in Ghana, for the benefit of the local school and the villagers. We have now heard that the work is complete, with £825 left over from the donation, which will be used to extend the electricity supply to the school classrooms.

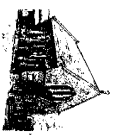
