DEANERY AND DIOCESAN EVENTS.

Bishop Declan will be celebrating Mass at Clifton Cathedral, on Saturday 30 April at 10.30am for those who were baptised or received into the Church this Easter. This is a real opportunity to draw together from across our diocese those who are celebrating the Sacraments of Initiation within our parish communities. Continuing that sense of welcome many received at the Rite of Election, this Mass gives us chance to draw these new Catholics and parish communities together to celebrate the gift of the Eucharist and the gift of faith with our bishop. Everyone is welcome to this celebration at the cathedral.

Catechists Symposium: This is an invitation to all catechists in our diocese, and all involved in handing on and encouraging faith in others, to come together for a day led by Fr Jonathan Stewart at Sacred Hearts' Parish Hall, Cheltenham, on Saturday 7 May, 10am to 3.30pm. A real opportunity for conversation, formation and nurturing.

Europe: Ahead of the referendum - an evening focused around the Church's contribution to Europe and its place within it. Does it have a voice in the European Community? Does it use it? Is it heard?
