**PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL ELECTIONS & CONTINUATIONS OF THE TWO AGM'S** At no point in the course of the Pandemic Crisis have any of our parish committees been disbanded, neither the Finance nor the Pastoral Council. Circumstances prevented us from meeting for a very long time. It was thought that the easing of Government restrictions and a lessening of the sense of crisis was a very good time to refresh and renew the Committees.
