**2021 THE YEAR OF ST JOSEPH** When Jesus speaks of the love of His Father in heaven, there are always echoes of St Joseph. God appointed him to teach the earthly Christ what love and fatherhood are supposed to be about. Growing up under the watchful care of St Joseph and Our Lady, Christ knew what it was to be given orders issued in love and which He obeyed in love. This is the background to this Sunday's Gospel. There is a distinct family aspect to this teaching on Church Life. He also sets martyrdom in this same context of loving obedience. Christ listened to St Joseph and to His Heavenly Father and then did what He was asked. I must do the same.

### MASS TEXTS

**Entrance Antiphon.**: Proclaim a joyful sound and let it be heard; proclaim to the ends of the earth: The Lord has freed his people, alleluia.

**Gloria** Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father. Lord Jesus Christ, Only-Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most-High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen

**First Reading**: Acts 10:25-26,34-35,44-48 *The Holy Spirit has been poured out on the pagans too*

**Gospel**: John 15:9-17 *Love one another as I have loved you.*

**Apostles Creed**: I believe in God the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from there He will come and judge the living and the dead.
